

When we refer to x lbs of fiber weight and dosage of 2% to 3% of Power Scour, Fibre Wash and Fibre Rinse based on that weight; you can use the below "civilian" guideline for hand laundering (which info. is basically on our bottle labels and which we will try to incorporate into our website.) The products as indicated below should be added to about 2 gallons of warm / hot water (depending on the fiber type). Hot for scouring and warm for gentle cleaning.

Oily or waxy wool/mohair*	1 lb		1 Tbsp Power Scour/FR
Dirty-non oily waxy alpaca/bison/cashmere*	1 lb.	2 Teaspoon PScour/FR	
Low-moderately dirty non oily/wax fiber*	1 lb.	1 Tbsp FWash/FR	
Sweater	-	1 Teaspoon FWash/FR	

*May require additional washes with Power Scour or Fibre Wash at half dosage as well as additional rinses. Fibre Rinse goes into the last rinse.

If there are 2 lbs of fiber (or a heavier garment) multiply the above by two, if three pounds multiply by three. Don't forget the amount of water may have to be increased to accommodate the additional amount of fiber.
